

# Application Deadline: 5pm September 2, 2019

The Doyle Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to qualified local high school graduates who attend Santa Rosa Junior College during the 2018-19 academic year to complete an Associate's Degree, certificate program, and/or units necessary to transfer to a four-year institution. Funds for these scholarships are provided through the Frank P. Doyle and Polly O'Meara Doyle Trust.

# Eligibility Criteria:

Students who meet all of the following eligibility requirements may apply:

- 1. Graduate from high school during the 2018-19 academic year; preference is given to local high school graduates. Homeschool students must provide a copy of their Private School Affidavit.
- 2. Currently have an **unweighted** overall High School Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher
  - after graduation, an official transcript will be required showing your graduation date and final **unweighted** GPA of 2.75 or higher
  - passage of the CHSPE exam is accepted in lieu of a high school diploma (attach an official high school transcript and a copy of your CHSPE certificate to your application)
  - passage of the GED exam or certificate of completion are not accepted in lieu of a high school diploma
- 3. Plan to enroll full-time (12 or more units) at Santa Rosa Junior College during the 2019-20 academic year
- 4. Submit a 2019-20 Free Application for Federal Student Aid otherwise known as FAFSA (https://fafsa.ed.gov/) or California Dream Act application (https://dream.csac.ca.gov/)

### Recipient Selection and Notification:

Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of factors including high school GPA, financial need, high school of attendance, and field of study. Applicants will be notified of award status by Summer 2020.

### **Award Amount:**

Awards will be offered at \$1,200 for the 2019-20 academic year.

Doyle Scholars from the Class of 2019 may be eligible to renew the scholarship for 2020-21.

### > Award Payments:

The 2019-20 Doyle Scholarship is paid in four \$300 installments over the course of the academic year upon regular verification of the student's qualifications. Selected recipients will receive complete details about claiming and maintaining their Doyle Scholarship for 2019-20 and the renewal process for 2020-21.

### High School Counselor GPA Verification:

Your high school counselor or advisor (director for homeschool students) will be asked to verify your GPA.
